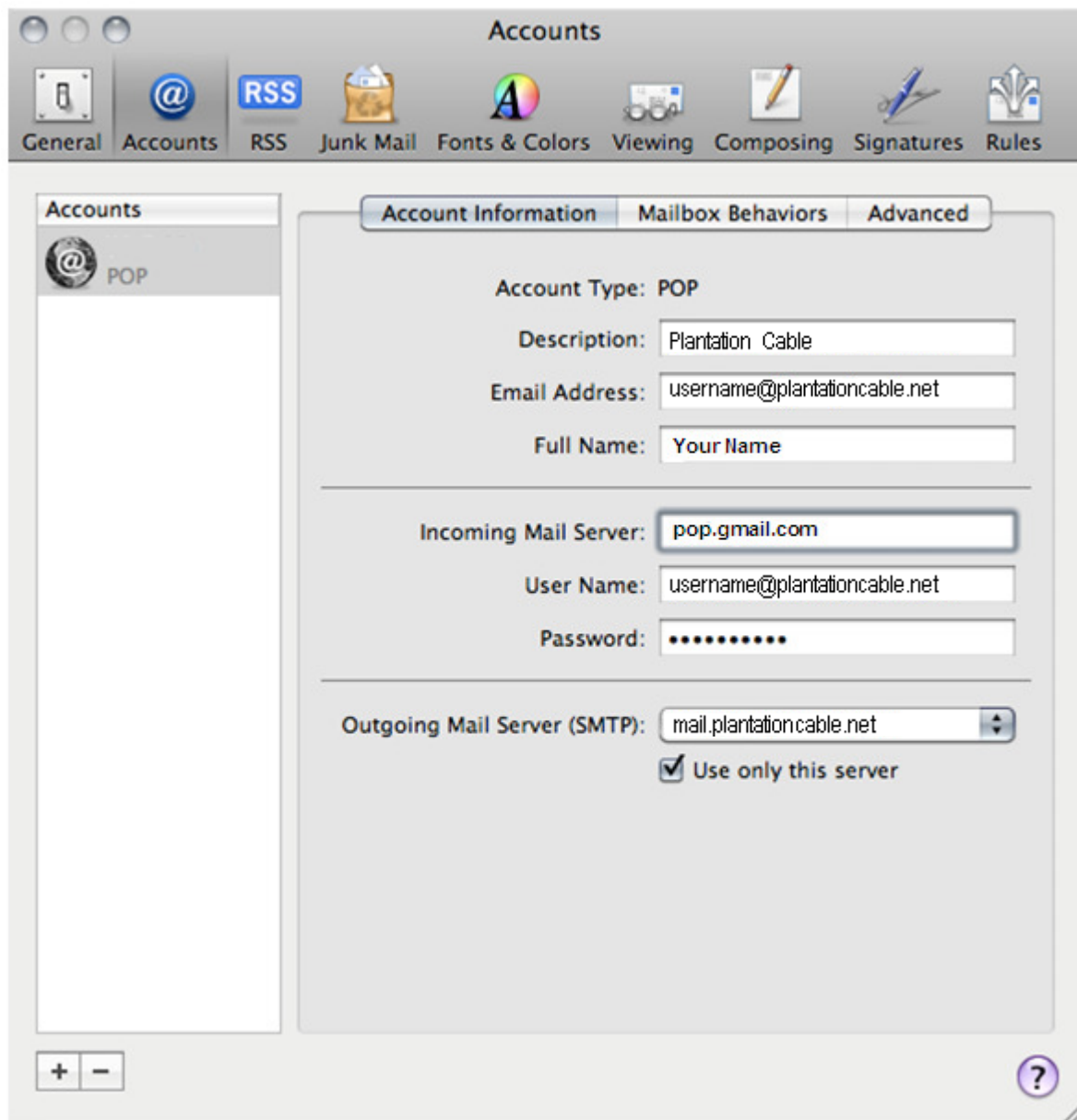


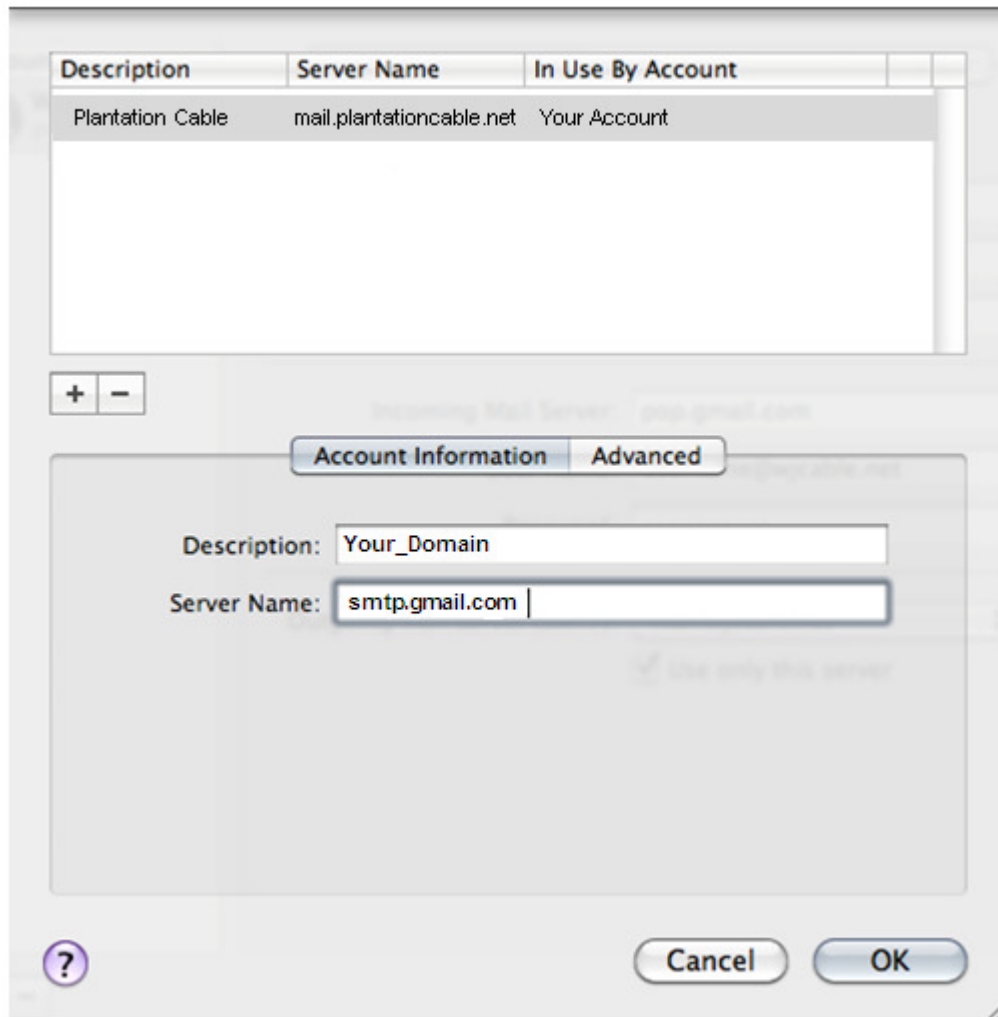
Apple Mail

Setting Your Outgoing (SMTP) Server Settings

1. Open Apple Mail.
2. Click **Mail**, and select **Preferences...**
3. Open the **Accounts** tab and select your existing Watson Cable TV account in the left panel.
4. **Setting up your outbound SMTP server.**
At the bottom of the right panel click the arrow to the right of **Outgoing Mail Server (SMTP)** and click “**Edit SMTP Server List ...**” from the dropdown.



You will be presented with the screen below.



5. In the Server Name field enter **smtp.gmail.com**. (You can optionally enter a description of this outbound server in the **Description** field.)

6. Click the **Advanced** tab and select **Use default port (25, 465, 587)**.
7. Put a check mark in the box next to **Use Secure Sockets Layer (SSL)**.
8. Click the arrow to the right of **Authentication** and choose **Password**.
9. Enter your full email address in the **Username** field.
10. Enter your password in the **Password** field and click **OK**

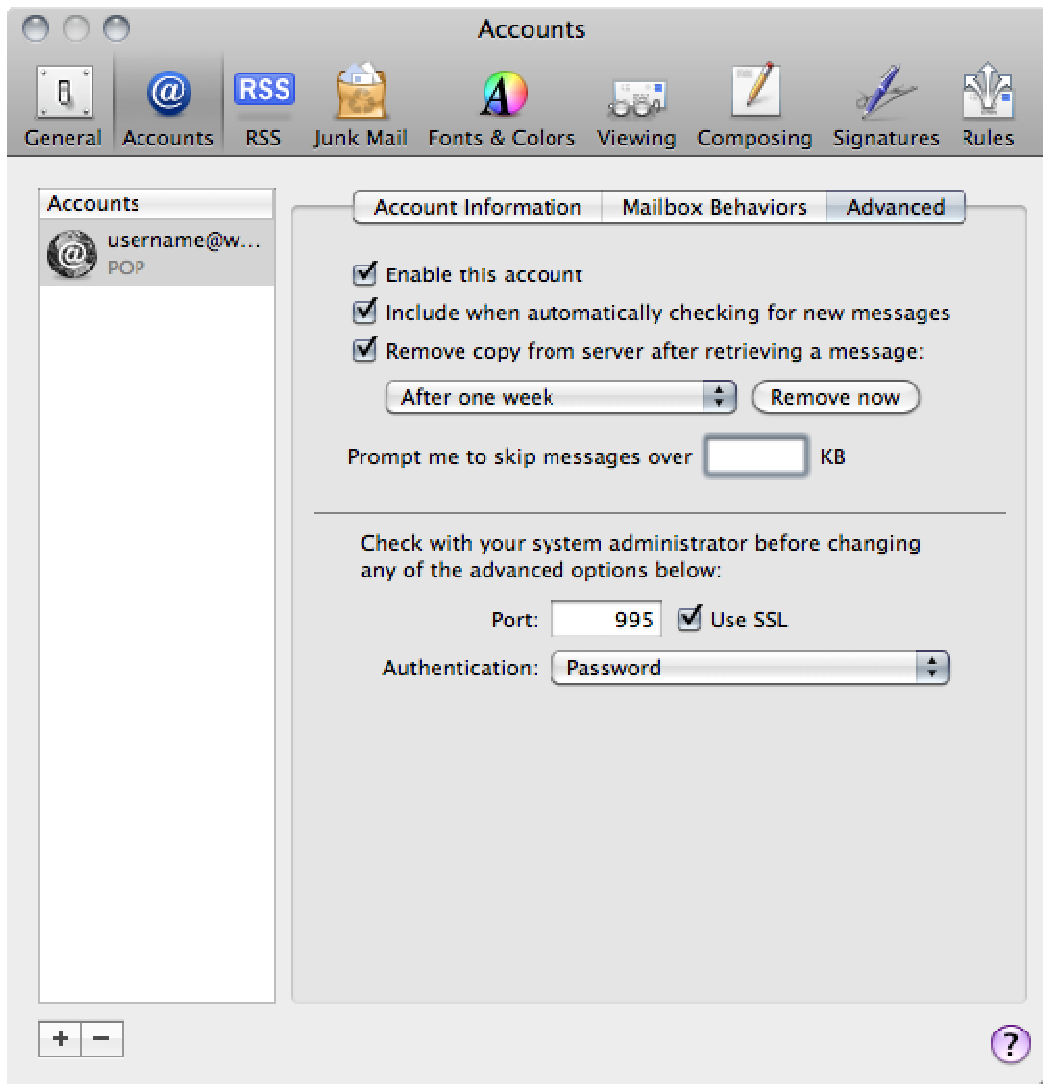

Setting Your Incoming (POP) Server Settings

1. At the **Accounts** screen click the **Advanced** tab.
2. Set the **Port** field to 995 and put a check mark in the box labeled **Use SSL**
3. Make sure **Authentication** is set to **Password** and the close button and confirm that you wish to save.
